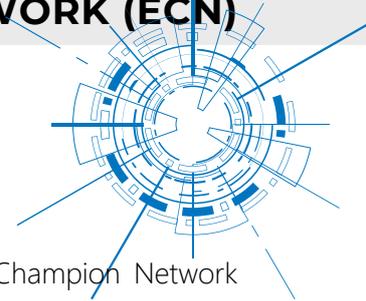


Bridging the Digital Divide for Girls in Nikli Upazila

Focus Outcome: Promoting Digital Inclusion for Girls (reduce digital divide)

Launched in 2022 with the generous support of the Malala Fund, the Education Champion Network initiative began its journey across five unions of Nikli Upazila—an outreach and climate-vulnerable area of Kishoreganj district. The project operates in eight secondary schools and thirty-one government primary schools. Recognizing the stark digital divide faced by adolescent girls in such rural settings, the initiative prioritized access to digital tools, skills, and learning opportunities to enhance their inclusion and educational advancement.
